### Rules of Entry

1. All exhibits in the competitive classes must be the property of the exhibitor.
2. No more than 2 entries per class per exhibitor, both of which may be awarded points, only one will receive prize money.
3. Exhibits must be staged between 9.30 am and 11.30 am on the day.
4. 30p entry fee for each exhibit.
5. Sale of exhibits will take place after the show and anyone not wishing their exhibits sold should remove them before the sale but not before 3.15 pm.
6. The Bisdee Challenge Cup will be awarded to the resident of Hartwell gaining most points in the vegetable, fruit and flower classes.
7. The Allcomers Cup will be awarded to the non-resident of Hartwell gaining most points in the vegetable, fruit and flower classes.
8. All classes will receive 3, 2, 1 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
9. Cash prizes will be 50p for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 40p for 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 30p for 3<sup>rd</sup> place unless otherwise specified.
10. All food produce must be labelled and dated within last 12 months.
11. All craft and photographic entries must be within last 12 months, clothing must not have been worn. Photographs must be printed on photographic paper.
12. The Judge's decision will be final.
13. The Top Tray and Top Vase rules are available on facebook, the website below or from Nigel Huckle.

Cups are awarded for the most points awarded in that section – the judge will make the final decision if same points given
